As the new school year is fast approaching, you might be thinking about what to buy for school clothes and supplies. Please read the additional back to school letter carefully, going over the additional information contained in it. These are some of the items from it we especially want to highlight: Hair needs to meet the appropriate length, guys, with clean shaved faces, and unnatural hair coloring is not acceptable for any student. Please remember to plan your wardrobe around the dress code, as outlined in the handbook.
